September 27, 2011

September 2011 - Trustees met at 6:30pm Sept. 13th. Trustees approved past meeting minutes. Trustees spent \$298.98 on repairs at the Paisley Parsonage. Trustees spent \$434.49 on repairs to the fridge in the CLC kitchen. Micah Parker has led the project to install sheetrock and seal the blocks in the hallway. Approx. \$650 will spent completing this. Trustees made a \$320 down payment on the new sign to replace the broken acrylic sign. Artwork is being prepared for approval. Lesha Sloan-Thompson reported her husband is repairing the A/C in the church bus. Approx. \$1200 will need to be approved for that repair. New tag for the bus was \$15.50. Stacey has determined that the Church has been paying sales tax on our electric bill. The Church could get as much as a \$6800 refund. We'll keep everyone posted. Trustees have estimated that it will cost approx. \$5600 for all the repairs and painting, etc. on the Paisley Parsonage. We may have to wait until money becomes available to pursue the repairs. Pastor Christy is planning on painting and replacing the carpet in the theater room. Any comments or concerns need to be addressed soon.
